Children's Home Society of Virginia is seeking temporary foster parents to care for infants and toddlers.

A foster care home study, training and support are provided. Foster parents also receive a monthly stipend and clothing allowance to meet each child's needs.

CHS requirements for foster parents:

- Must have a loving and nurturing home environment that is smoke-free.
- If the foster parent is married, he or she must be married for three years.
- The parents must be between the ages of 25 and 65 years.
- One parent must be available to meet the child's day-to-day needs.
- An agency-approved pediatrician must be used for medical care.
- The foster parents are responsible for taking the child to the doctor for routine checkups and sick visits.
- The parents must be able to take a child of any age (infancy to preschool) and of any racial heritage or sex.
- The foster parents must have an agency-approved home study and meet other licensing requirements.
