TPP Youth Partner with SunTrust for Financial Literacy Program As of August 2018, The Possibilities Project has partnered with SunTrust to launch a new and exciting financial curriculum, which tackles som of the most important areas of financial education: managing money in the digital age, savings, future planning and investments, debt management and credit. Our young adults will participate in a course each month, each focuse on a different area of financial education. This partnership allows our youth to learn key financial concepts from banking experts and to participate in important adult discussions.

TPP's ongoing work to teach financial skills is empowering these young adults to take control of their lives. Program managers engage our youth in a variety of ways to teach financial education...from trips to banking institutions, to watching related documentaries, to sitting with them individually and breaking down their own monthly expenditures.
